CHILDREN'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH:

Family Life Counseling & Psychiatric services is proud to offer the Norwalk Community a behavioral health center specifically for children and youth.

Since the COVID-19 pandemic, we prioritized creating a center for children specifically. We felt that this was important for this demographic due to children being forced to isolate themselves from friends, unable to maintain a sense of normalcy in the home, and cope with minimal access to friends of extended families.

This site was created to provide a space for children and youth that is just as unique as their individual needs. It was created for children to feel welcome and comfortable in a space created for them.

SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUAL CHILDREN:

Early Childhood, birth to 5

Offering individualized support and information for new and experienced parents or guardians

Child Centered Play Therapy, ages 3 to 5

Evidence-based therapy to assist children in recognizing and communicating their emotions and needs to others

Individual Therapy, ages 3 to 18

Structured one-on-one support for children with various emotional and behavioral concerns

SERVICES TO INCLUDE PARENTS & GROUPS:

Filial Therapy for Children & Parents, ages 3-10

Research-driven therapy for families to improve understanding and interacting with youth

Adventure Group Therapy, as appropriate

Evidence-based therapy to teach children problem-solving techniques and engage in positive interactions with others

Family Counseling, all ages

Established to bridge communication within families, as well as establish or review expectations and roles of each person

Parenting Classes, all ages

Created to assist parents in establishing roles, expectations and boundaries within relationships with their children

Child & Parent Psychotherapy, all ages

Individual therapy for children and parents to bridge communication and assist with conflict management

Adoption Mental Health Services, all ages

Created assist new parents in building relationships, open communication, and setting expectations with youth

Therapeutically Supervised Child & Parent Visitation, all ages

We will gladly work with community resources to support and bridge communication between parents and children

School-Based Counseling, all ages

We gladly partner with individual schools and districts to provide in-school mental health counseling that will be scheduled appropriately with student class schedules
